

## **Check the Road Signs to Follow The Doubling Rule Game**

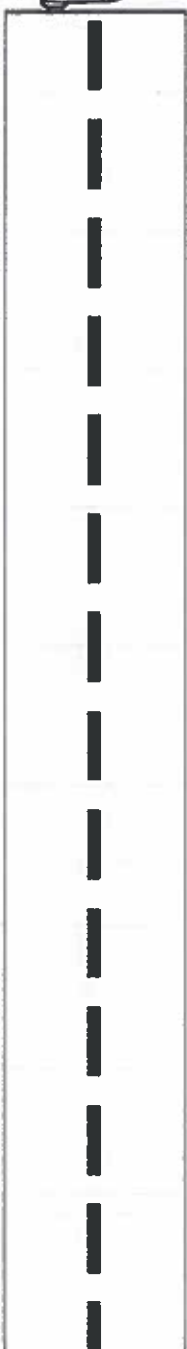
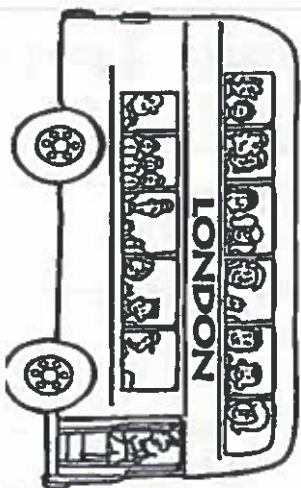
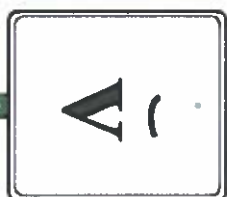
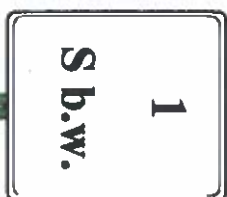
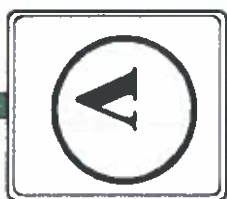
1. Place the car on top of the bus on the game board.
2. Read:

### **The Doubling Rule**

**When adding a vowel suffix to a one syllable base word ending in a short vowel and one consonant, you must double the final consonant before adding the vowel suffix.**

3. Look at the first word on the game board. Follow the road signs to decide if you need to double the final consonant in the base word. Move the car forward to each road sign if it describes the word you want to spell. If you make it all the way to the end of the road, you know you must double the final consonant of the base word.
4. Write the derivative, base word plus the suffix, on the line on the game board or in your journal.
