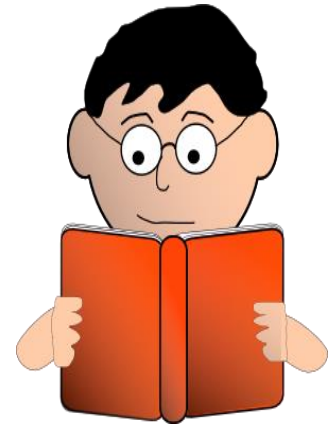


Strategies for Reading Longer Words



Circle prefixes I know at the beginning of the word.

in- dis- mis-
sub- re- pre-



Circle suffixes I know at the end of the word.

-s -ing -ed
-less -ness -ly



Look for syllable division patterns I know.

vccv words

Napkin Rule vc' / cv

Secret Rule v' / ccv

vcv words

Label Rule v' / cv

Dragon Rule vc' / v



Code the syllables.

- Code the vowel sound.
- Mark out silent letters.
- Make any other codings necessary.



Read the word.

Does it sound right?

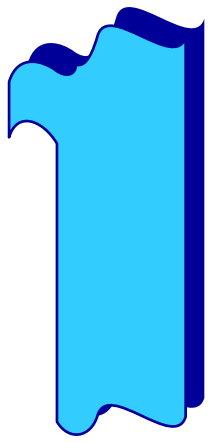
Does it make sense?

If not, use a different syllable division pattern and re-read.



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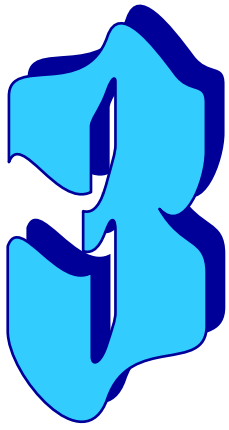
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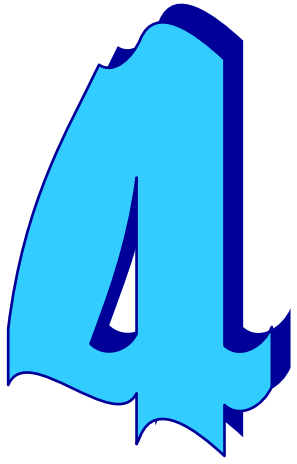
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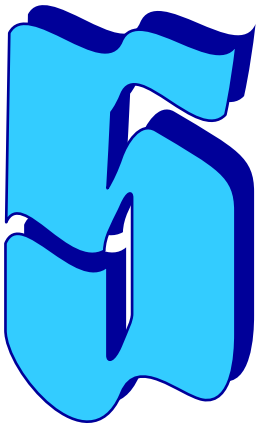




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
